

In response to bills passed during the 79th and 80th legislative sessions, the Student Assessment Division has updated the previously released testing calendar for the 2008–2009 school year and has initiated the development of the testing calendar for the 2009–2010 school year. These efforts have been undertaken to comply with both the legislative requirement to maintain a three-year testing calendar and the recent Senate Bill (SB) 1031 requirement to move the spring administrations to occur later in the school year.

Draft versions of the 2008–2009 and 2009–2010 testing calendars will be posted to the Student Assessment Division website for public review until **September 26, 2007**. Both calendars have been modeled after the recently revised 2007–2008 calendar and reflect other important changes in the Texas assessment program. In particular, the calendar has been adjusted to reflect the decisions of many school districts to end the 2008–2009 and 2009–2010 school years one week later than the 2007–2008 school year.

To the extent possible, assessment dates and testing windows have been selected to minimize conflicts with religious, state, or national holidays and nationally scheduled examinations, and to provide the least disruptive schedule for districts. The grades and subjects for each assessment program specified are in accordance with state and federal regulations.

As you review these calendars, please keep in mind the implications of any changes that you wish to propose. For example, moving test dates later in the school year can affect the reporting of test results and the timing of subsequent test administrations as well as pose conflicts with other activities such as AP testing or UIL competitions.

To assist in your review of the draft calendars, below is a summary of important changes.

Changes introduced in the 2008–2009 calendar

- All stand-alone TAKS field testing has been eliminated for 2008–2009 except for Spanish field tests at grades 5 and 6.
- Physics and world geography end-of-course online field tests have been added.
- TAKS–M retests have been added to the second and third administrations of SSI reading at grade 3 and reading and mathematics at grades 5 and 8.
- TAKS–M retests for grade 11 English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies have been added in July 2009.
- Students who require LAT administrations of TAKS–M will test at the same time as all other LAT testers.
- The second administration of mathematics at grades 5 and 8 has been moved back one week to allow the same amount of time for accelerated instruction as in previous years.

Changes introduced in the 2009–2010 calendar

- English I and Algebra II end-of-course online field tests have been added.
- TAKS–M retests have been added to all exit level administrations.
